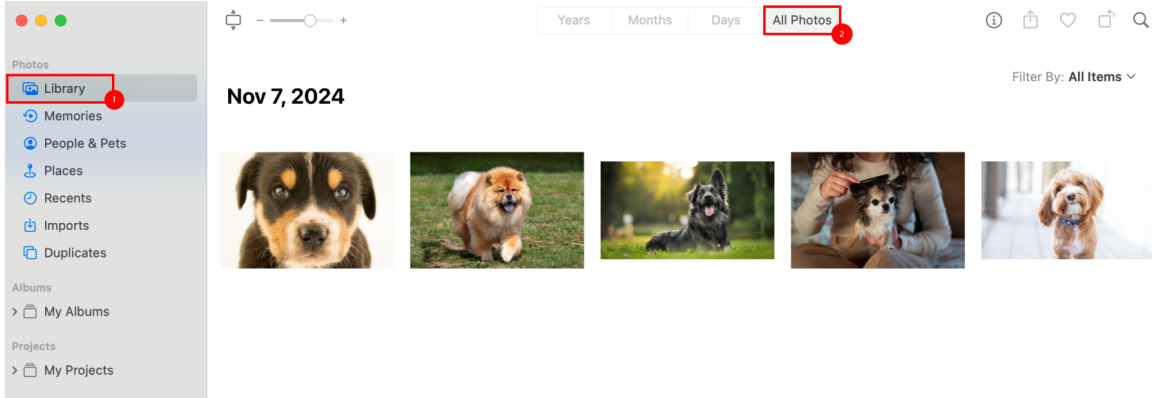


# Export from the Photos App

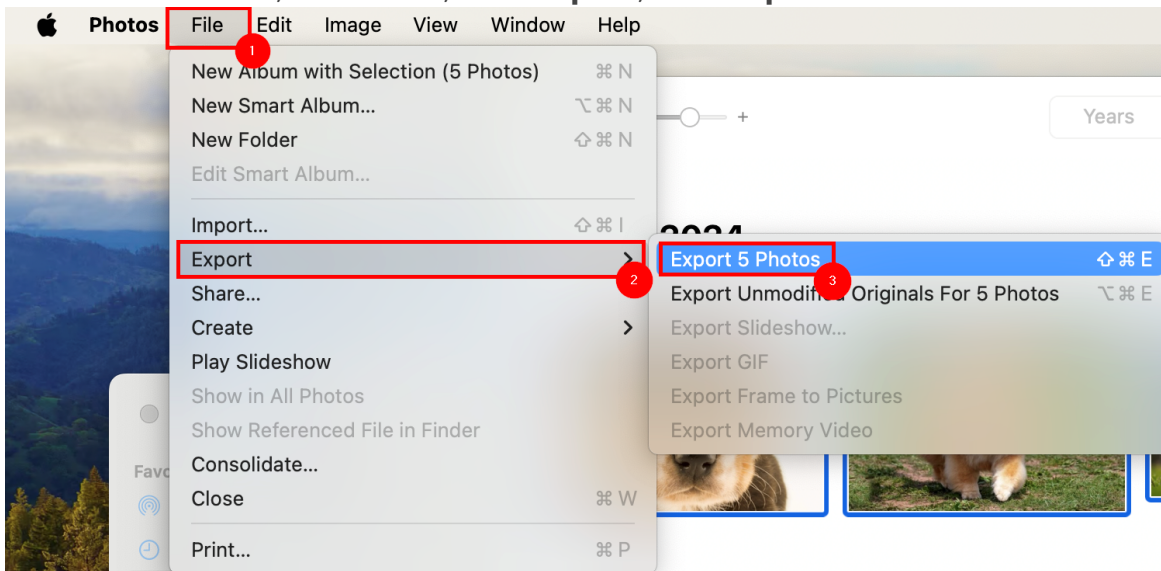
Ensure the *Photos* app is open.

In the *Photos* app, select **Library** from the left pane, then the **All Photos** tab from the top.



Press **Command+A** to select all photos.

From the *Menu Bar*, select **File**, then **Export**, then **Export X Photos**.



In the *Confirmation Window*, leave the defaults as shown, and select **Export**.

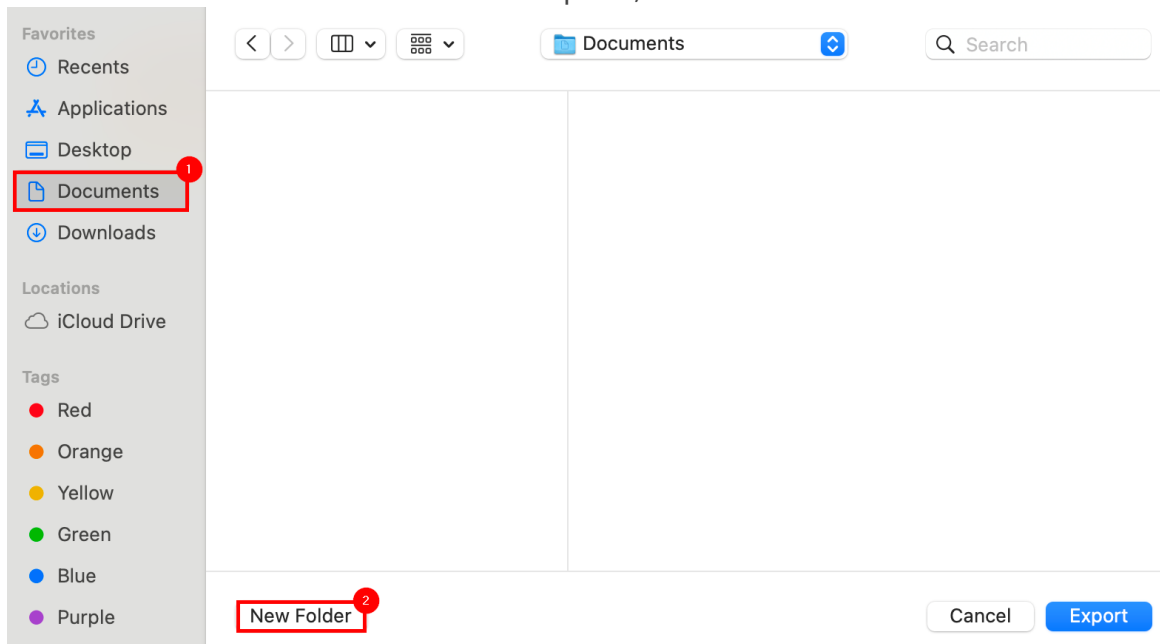

A *Finder* window will open.

Select **Documents** from the left menu pane, then **New Folder** from the bottom left.



In the *New Folder* dialogue, enter **My Photos** as the folder name, and select **Create**.

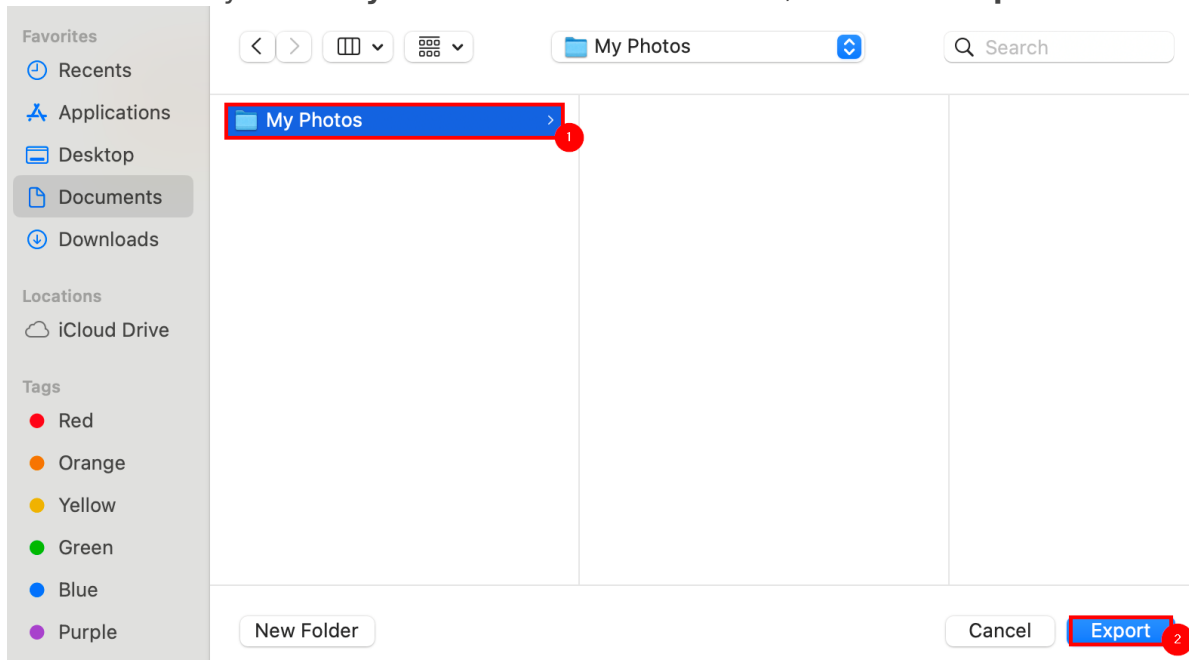
## New Folder

Select the newly made **My Photos** folder within *Finder*, and select **Export** from the bottom right.



The MacBook will take some time to process the export of all photos.

When complete, view the newly made **My Photos** folder to verify the export's success.
